

Student Officer Role Description

Excerpt from The Constitution and Rules of the Students' Union (Rule 4)

17. THE POSTGRADUATE TAUGHT OFFICER

They:

- 17.1 Shall be a Postgraduate Taught Student, as defined by the University.
- 17.2 Shall be concerned with general issues relating to Postgraduate Taught Students. They shall also be responsible for liaison with organisations, both external and internal to the University, which are relevant to Postgraduate Taught Students.
- 17.3 Shall represent the interests of Postgraduate Taught Students to the Executive Management Committee and to the University Authorities, and shall campaign on issues that impact upon the student experience of Postgraduate Taught Students.
- 17.4 Shall encourage greater involvement of Postgraduate Taught Students in Union affairs.
- 17.5 Shall be a voting member of the Students' Union Council and the Executive Management Committee.
