Responsibilities: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Work with the 6 Full-Time Student Officers in the day-to-day running of the Union. 2. Attend and be an active member of Student Council and the Executive Management Committee of the Union. Council meets about once a month, and EMC meets once every two weeks. 3. Run campaigns on the issues that are important to students, in the Union, the University and beyond. 4. Encourage students to be more involved in the Union. 5. Listen to students and be their voice in the Students' Union. 6. Run campaigns on the issues that are important to students, on their course, on campus, in the Union, in the University, in the community, or in the world. 7. Work with the Union, the University and external organisations to make positive change for students.
